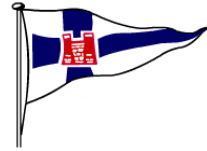

NOTICE OF RACE

1 ORGANISING AUTHORITY

1.1 The Organising Authority(OA) will be Lough Erne Yacht Club (LEYC), in association with the International J24 Association of Ireland.

2 RULES

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016. No National Authority Prescriptions will apply;
- 2.2 International J24 Class Rules will apply. Download from www.j24class.org;

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 **General.** The regatta is open to boats of the International J24 class whose helm or registered owner is a member of a National J24 Class Association recognised by the International J24 Class Association.
- 3.2 **Registration** The entry form will be available at registration and Individual Membership Forms will also be available at the Regatta Race Office on Friday 29th August 1000-1400. All helms must provide a valid measurement certificate at registration and crews will be required to weigh in.
- 3.3 **Entry Fee.** Required fees are as follows
Class Registration: £50 or €60
Event Entry: £100 or €125

4 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

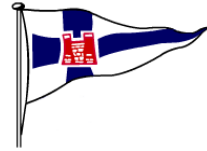

- 5.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000.

6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Crane facilities will be available from 10am-2pm on Friday 29th August or prior to this by appointment.
- 6.2 It is proposed to sail eight races.
- 6.3 Proposed Schedule of Races
- 6.3.1 Friday 29th August: up to 2 races
- 6.3.2 Saturday 30th August: up to 4 races
- 6.3.3 Sunday 31st August: remaining races to complete series of eight.
- 6.3.4 No race will be started after 14.00hrs Sunday 31st August, except for postponements, general recalls and abandonments shortly after the start.

9 SCORING

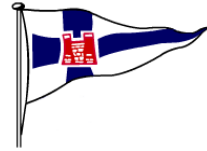
- 9.1 Four races are required to be completed to constitute a series
- 9.2 When fewer than five races have been sailed, a boats' series score will be the total of her race scores

9.3 When five or more races have been completed, a boats' series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
