

## **NOTICE OF RACE**

### **AUTUMN REGATTA**

#### **Lough Erne Yacht Club 20<sup>th</sup> September 2014**

Lough Erne Yacht Club is the Organising Authority for the Autumn Regatta on Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2014. Members and Visitors are invited.

**RULES** – The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, Class Rules (with LEYC amendments) this Notice, the Entry Form and Sailing Instructions.

**FORMAT** – Five races over the day. The starting sequence and sound and visual signals used will be as detailed in the Sailing Instructions. Each Start signal will coincide with the next Warning Signal. Courses will be set for a time duration intending that fleets finish about the same time. Races will be sailed "back to back" until the Postponement Signal is flown. See the Sailing Instructions.

Friday 19th - evening, Boat Preparation, Crane, final Registration, and Bar.

Saturday 20th - Briefing for all crews at 8.30 am

Saturday 20th - First Warning Signal 10.00 am

Saturday 20th – Prize Giving, approximately 5.00 pm

Saturday 20th - 6.00 pm, Regatta BBQ or Dinner, Bar & music

**SAFETY** – All competitors shall wear personal flotation. The safety of a boat and her entire management shall be the sole responsibility of the Skipper.

**DISCLAIMER** - Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, See RRS 4. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**INSURANCE** - each participating boat shall be covered by valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £ 2 million per event or the equivalent.

**ELIGIBILITY** – a boat is eligible to race when its Entry Form is accepted with undertakings signed on Safety, on Insurance, and (excepting visitors) on paid-up membership of LEYC and payment of entry fee.

**COURSES** – See the **Sailing Instructions**

**SCORING** – See the **Sailing Instructions**

**FOOD** – Regatta Dinner, Saturday 6 pm, £8 per person, pre-paid with menu choice–form to be returned or BBQ facilities provided for own cooking.

**ENTRY FORM** – Please lodge entry (and dinner) forms ahead of the regatta with a Fleet Captain or in LEYC post box.

**ENTRY FEE** - The entry fee will be £10 (£5 under 16) and should be submitted with the entry form.
