

NOTICE OF RACE - AUTUMN REGATTA

Lough Erne Yacht Club 17th /18th June 2016

Lough Erne Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority for the Autumn Regatta on Saturday 17th June 2016. Members and Visitors are invited.

RULES – The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016, Class Rules (with LEYC amendments) this Notice, the Entry Form and Sailing Instructions.

FORMAT – Six races over the two days. The starting sequence and sound and visual signals used will be as detailed in the Sailing Instructions. Racing may be in the form of 3 different fleets/combined fleets. J24, Yeoman and other Keel boats, dinghies. Any boat without a yardstick number may be assigned an approximate number by the Race Committee.

Friday 16th - evening, Boat Preparation, Crane, and Bar.

Saturday 17 – Registration 12.30am. Briefing for all crews at 1.30 am

Saturday 17th - First Warning Signal 2.00 pm

Saturday 17th - 6.00 pm, BBQ, Bar & music

Sunday 18th – First Warning Signal 11.00am

Sunday 18th – Prize Giving, approximately 4.00 pm

SAFETY – All competitors shall wear personal flotation. The safety of a boat and her entire management shall be the sole responsibility of the Skipper.

DISCLAIMER - Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk, See RRS 4. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

INSURANCE - each participating boat shall be covered by valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £ 2 million per event or the equivalent.

ELIGIBILITY – a boat is eligible to race when its Entry Form is accepted with undertakings signed on Safety, on Insurance, and (except visitors) on paid-up membership of LEYC and payment of entry fee.

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

These will be available at registration.

COURSES – **Will be posted on the official notice Board 30 minutes before the start of the relevant race.**

SCORING – **Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series. Further info – see S.I.**

FOOD – BBQ facilities provided for own cooking.

ENTRY FEE - The entry fee will be £10 (£5 under 16) and should be submitted with the entry form.
