Sailing Instructions

Organising Authority: Lough Erne Yacht Club

1. Rules.

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. Notices to competitors.

Notices will be posted on the Official Notice board.

3. Changes to Sailing Instructions.

Any changes will be posted before 10.00 am on the day they will take effect.

4. Signals.

These will be displayed from the club flagpole, or from the club committee boat.

5. Schedule of races.

Up to six races are scheduled with three "back to back" on each day. The warning signal on Saturday at 12.00 and on Sunday at 11.00.

6. Course, Marks, Start and Finish.

Courses will be windward - leeward.

The Start and Finish line will be between the main mast of the club committee boat and a pink mark.

Any boat starting more than five minutes after her starting signal will be scored DNS.

7. Penalties.

RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will apply.

8. Protests and requests for redress.

Protests forms will be available in the Race Office and the time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day.

9. Scoring.

Three races completed will constitute a series.

When five races or less have been sailed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.

When six races have been completed, a boats series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. Prizes.

A schedule of prizes will be displayed on the Official Notice board.

11. Disclaimer of liability.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to race.

The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

12. Insurance.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000.
